

## LUISA<sup>®</sup> Device Overview




- **1** External battery connection

## Plugging In

LUISA® can be powered by plugging into an outlet or via an internal battery; a fully charged battery can last up to 6 hours.

To plug the device into an outlet for power, connect the power supply cord into the connection on device and the cord into an outlet



## Turning LUISA<sup>®</sup> On

- Press the On/Off button
- Once On, the device automatically performs a few function tests and then the start screen is displayed



## Starting Therapy | Ending Therapy | Mode Selection

## Starting Therapy

Starting Therapy is completed by:

- 1 briefly pressing the On/Off button OR
- 2 pressing the Start Therapy key in display -



## Ending Therapy

Ending Therapy is completed by:

- 1 holding the On/Off button long enough to allow the green progress bar to fill. Then confirm the end of therapy by pressing the On/Off button again OR
- 2 pressing End Therapy key in display long enough to allow the green progress bar to fill. Then confirm the end of therapy.



#### Mode Selection

The Program Selection key allows selection between the programmed modes of ventilation your physician has prescribed \_\_\_\_\_



### Filter Changes

- The LUISA has 2 filters to keep dust and other particles out of the device. The filters are found at the back of the device.
- The fine filter (white) is closest to the machine and needs to be replaced monthly. Do not clean this filter.
- The coarse filter (black) needs to be rinsed and dried monthly and replaced every 6 months.
